Kyla's Hip Surgery

On September 13th @ 7:30 am I had my left hip replacement surgery @ Norwood Hospital in Norwood, MA. The surgery went great and was about a 2.5 hour procedure. I have to admit I was in denial about what to expect when I woke up. The last night I spent anytime in the hospital was about 40 years ago when I had my tonsils out. I didn't mind being woken up for vitals, or to have my blood drawn, but the constant noise I never got used to. I didn't sleep for almost a week. By the time I got to rehab, I was so used to not sleeping that every time my body would get relaxed, it started to jerk as if it was telling me don't even think of falling asleep tonight. A couple of weeks before my surgery I had a severe allergic reaction to my new thyroid medication for my newly diagnosed Graves Disease. After spending the day before Labor Day in the ER, I was sent for more tests and blood work. The itching and pain was so severe I didn't sleep for 3 nights. It was like my skin was crawling and I couldn't scratch deep enough. So before having surgery I was already sleep deprived. I couldn't wait to have the surgery and silly me thought to sleep! The day after surgery they had me up sitting in a chair and the third day I was walking down the hall with a walker. On Friday, Brian, Andrew, and Courtney (Andy's girlfriend) came to visit and played Canasta. It was wonderful to see them and took my mind off of any pain. On Saturday, September 17th, I arrived at New Bridge on the Charles in Dedham, MA to begin my rehab. The facility is only two years old is on 126 acres and is an amazing place. The staff, therapists, nurses, doctors, have all been so wonderful. They were so good at listening to my concerns and just listening when I couldn't get to sleep. Finally on day 7, I was able to get 4 hours of straight sleep. Ahh, my body started to feel like it was healing and no longer traumatized. I never really had any terrible pain, a lot of stiffness and headaches from not letting my brain recharge and being able to relax. On Wednesday, September 28th, after spending 10 days in rehab, I was discharged with crutches. I told them to keep my bed warm, as I would see them in January! xoxo
